2020 LAST STOP VINEYARD

PINOT NOIR

Located in the Green Valley, a sub-AVA in the Russian River Valley, our estate vineyard Last Stop experienced a dry winter and a warmer-than-typical summer. Low rainfall and late summer heat followed a warm, mild growing season, accelerating ripening. The season started with a few frost events in early spring, which reduced yields and set the stage for wines with intensity and structure. The crop of small, concentrated berries highlighted the depth, complexity and textural expression of Pinot Noir that we love from Last Stop. After we began harvesting on August 18, we picked the two

that we love from Last Stop. After we began harvesting on August 18, we picked the two blocks which make up most of this bottling, Block 9 and Block 1, on August 24 and 25, respectively, making this blend almost entirely from the Swan clone of Pinot Noir.

The 2020 Last Stop bottling illustrates the balance that can be found in a warm vintage with the ripe, mature tannin profile lending a creamy texture to the mid-palate and a thread of acidity lifting the palate and aromas. There is a strong floral, rose petal element to this wine, adding complexity to the forward Russian River berry and cherry notes. While intense and concentrated, this wine does not sacrifice elegance and finesse, highlighting the nuance from this exceptional site.
