ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

2021 was an exceptional vintage in Anderson Valley. A cool, dry winter and spring slowed down early season vine growth and produced balanced canopy architecture. Some unsettled spring weather during bloom also reduced yields. With historically low rainfall, summer was warm and dry, producing small berries of great concentration.

This Rosé is a blend of three separate blocks at Bearman Bend Vineyard, planted to a compelling mix of unique heritage clones. All three blocks were harvested on September 6 and fermented separately in neutral oak and stainless drums to build texture and maintain freshness. Block 1 sits on a south-facing plateau at the western edge of the ranch. It lends a vibrant, floral, wild berry note to the bouquet while boosting the body and depth of the palate. Blocks 5 and 6 sit above the barrel cave with a southwestern aspect, and they contribute an intense freshness and energy to the palate while adding citrus zest, mineral and floral notes on the nose. The overall balance and intensity of this 2021 Rosé is a great reflection of the classic vintage in Anderson Valley.
