PINOT NOIR

2021 was an exceptional vintage in Anderson Valley. A cool, dry winter and spring slowed down early season vine growth and produced balanced canopy architecture. Some unsettled spring weather during bloom also reduced yields. With historically low rainfall, summer was warm and dry, producing small berries and therefore wines of great concentration. Temperatures warmed up in the fall, pushing the clusters up over the last ascent to maturity with fully developed flavor and balanced acidity. Just under

ninety percent of this single vineyard bottling comes from Blocks 14 and 15, planted to the Swan and Mount Eden clonal selections with a strong south and southeastern exposure.

The 2021 Bearman Bend Vineyard Pinot Noir is an excellent example of the wines this estate can produce. A warm and inviting nose highlighted by cherry and baking spices with a resinous undertone leads to a broad, bright wine on approach. Notes of Rainier cherry, candied orange and rosemary are backed by refined tannins. The finish is long and bright with hints of apple peel and lingering acidity.
