GARYS' VINEYARD

PINOT NOIR

Located in the Santa Lucia Highlands AVA, Garys' Vineyard experienced a calm and methodical growing season. This type of vintage often produces classic wines, and 2021 is no exception with elegance and balance on full display. Adding up to single digits, rainfall totals were below typical—roughly half of what the already dry region receives in an average year. Spring was cool and dry, priming the plants to conserve resources and grow smaller canopies as well as a balanced crop. Summer and fall were both warm and mild, allowing for even and steady ripening without some of the more dramatic heat waves.

We harvested our two blocks at Garys' Vineyard separately with the Mount Eden clonal selection starting off the season on September 11, followed by the Pisoni clonal selection on September 14. These two one-acre blocks were blended with the former lending a supple, elegant texture to the palate and the latter providing a refined tannin framing. The resulting wine is a single vineyard bottling that is lively and complex with freshness, elegance and a persistent finish.
