2022 BEARMAN BEND VINEYARD

ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

The 2022 growing season in Anderson Valley was cool and dry, gradually warming then ending with a surprising staccato of heat in early September. Vines from the estate's three blocks of heritage clones that make up the 2022 Bearman Bend Vineyard Rosé—Blocks 1, 5 and 6—responded by steadily growing balanced canopies then adding a shot of concentrated traditional Pinot Noir flavors at ripening.

After flavors developed and acidity softened, the blocks were harvested by hand and directly pressed, allowing the juice to have limited skin contact. Once settled, the juice was fermented and wine cellared on light lees in a mixture of neutral French oak barrels and stainless-steel drums to build texture while maintaining freshness, minerality and adding a bit of structure.

Picking early in the warm season resulted in a bright, lively rosé of Pinot Noir with delicate aromas of alpine strawberry and white peach. With crisp mouthwatering citrus, white cherry and juicy hibiscus flavors, this wine delights the palate then finishes with a touch of spice and cherry nougat.
