PINOT NOIR

Abundant winter rains enveloped the West Sonoma Coast during winter and early spring, providing ample moisture for vigorous vine growth throughout the season. The extended, cool and occasionally damp flowering phase produced intriguing cluster formations, with small berries intermingled with larger ones, contributing to the development of nuanced, layered tannins in the final wine.

As summer progressed, warmer temperatures hastened the ripening process. Positioned just three miles from the Pacific Ocean, Hirsch Vineyard benefits from significant maritime influence, mitigating some of the heat events experienced in 2022. Harvesting our sections of block 11 on September 5—following a period of warmth to ensure optimal ripeness, yet before temperatures soared—allowed us to capture the essence of the fruit at its peak.

The 2022 Hirsch Vineyard Pinot Noir unfolds with aromas of sage, earth and bramble, leading to a tightly knit mid-palate imbued with acidity and structure. While the wine possesses a sturdy backbone, it maintains balance with a velvety, refined tannin texture that lingers into a lifted, enduring finish.
