GARYS' VINEYARD

PINOT NOIR

The 2023 vintage reflects the synergy of a stellar growing season and a world-class site. Located in the wind-swept Santa Lucia Highlands, this vineyard benefited from a notably wet winter, receiving over 20 inches of rainfall—well above the region's average. Cold temperatures followed, leading to a budbreak nearly three weeks later than normal. Steady coastal winds maintained ripening throughout the season, safeguarding freshness and prolonging hang time to achieve ideal fruit maturity.

Our three blocks at Garys' were harvested individually over a two-week span, highlighting the site's slow, steady ripening. The Mt. Eden block was picked first on September 22, followed by two Pisoni clone blocks on September 29 and October 4. This extended window allowed each block to be brought in at peak balance.

The resulting wine is a seamless blend of power and precision. The Mt. Eden clone delivers vibrant strawberry, blackberry and floral aromatics, while the Pisoni clone contributes depth, structure and length. On the palate, the wine is energetic and layered with ripe fruit, supple tannins and a persistent finish that speaks to both the site and the season. The 2023 Garys' Vineyard Pinot Noir is a vivid, detailed expression of this iconic location.
