HIRSCH VINEYARD

PINOT NOIR

The 2023 vintage on the West Sonoma Coast was marked by extremes, beginning with a winter of intense atmospheric rivers that saturated the region. Hirsch Vineyard, perched above the fog line just three miles from the Pacific Ocean, absorbed the weight of these storms. As a result, the season tracked three to four weeks behind average, with each stage of vine development progressing slowly and deliberately.

Hirsch is a site known for its rugged beauty and precision. Typically slow to ripen, it often demands a swift response once flavor and tannin maturity align. In 2023, the extended harvest window allowed us to wait for perfect ripeness without pressure. On October 6, we harvested both sections of Block 11, marking the first time this fruit has been picked outside of September and a full month later than in 2022. Uncork the aromas of dried herbs, umami and forest floor as they frame a core of mature berry notes. The palate is firm and concentrated, with ample tannins and a clean line of acidity that carries through a long, mineral finish. The 2023 Hirsch Vineyard Pinot Noir is rooted in site and shaped by season, offering power, restraint and a true sense of place. It showcases the essence of a remote site where maturity is earned slowly and complexity comes naturally.
