LAST STOP VINEYARD

PINOT NOIR

The 2023 growing season brought a welcome return to the cool, slow-ripening conditions that define the Russian River Valley. After the early harvest and warm days of 2022, a series of atmospheric rivers delivered generous rainfall that replenished soil moisture and supported strong, healthy vine growth. Spring remained cool and wet, with steady canopy development and a delayed fruit set. The season moved at a deliberate pace, with no days exceeding triple-digit temperatures, and harvest stretched nearly a month later than the previous year. Last Stop Block 9, planted to the Swan selection of Pinot Noir makes up the core of this single vineyard designate. The final blend includes fruit from five blocks —9, 10, 1, 15B and 8—featuring four clones: Swan, 115, 95 and 66.1. These distinctive clones come together to paint a complete picture of what this beautiful ranch can produce .

The extended hang time and cooler temperatures allowed for impressive, resolved tannins combined with lifted, fresh acidity. Aromatically, the wine opens with bergamot, incense and dried herbs, followed by layered notes of Santa Rosa plum and black cherry. The palate is focused and textural, with a taut mid-palate that gives way to a long, creamy finish. This wine reflects the patience and precision of the vintage. It captures the nuance of the Russian River Valley's maritime climate and showcases the strength of Last Stop's most expressive blocks in a classically styled, cool-climate Pinot Noir.
