MONUMENT TREE VINEYARD

PINOT NOIR

Located in the depths of Anderson Valley just 11 miles from the Pacific Ocean, Monument Tree Vineyard is our coldest and most coastal estate site. Marked by its namesake lightning-struck redwood, this iconic vineyard excelled in the classically cool 2023 vintage. A wet winter punctuated by atmospheric rivers gave way to a late, slow-developing spring. Summer brought mild temperatures with just enough warmth to ripen both flavor and tannin. As fall arrived, a mix of sunny days and a timely rainstorm necessitated a calm, patient approach to harvest. All vineyard blocks for this wine were picked during the second week of October with precision and intent.

Composed of Dijon clones 115, 667 and 777 from blocks 10, 12, 7, 6 and 9, this bottling reflects the nuance and depth of Monument Tree. The wine opens with layers of spice, black tea and redwood bark—signature traits of the site. On the palate, it is structured and focused with fine, layered tannins wrapped around a core of fresh dark berries, dried herbs and savory spice. A backbone of acidity drives the wine forward and frames the long, detailed finish.

The 2023 Monument Tree Vineyard Pinot Noir is a powerful yet elegant expression of this coastal vineyard. Its complexity and natural energy highlight the unique character of the site and the strength of the vintage.
