BEARMAN BEND VINEYARD

ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

The bright flavors and gorgeous acidity of the Bearman Bend Vineyard Rosé of Pinot Noir from the 2023 vintage is a mirrored expression of the region's growing season—balanced and superlative. This bottling comes from three blocks of Heritage selections, blocks 1, 5 and 6. What started as a mild, excellent growing season—slow and steady—picked up in pace as fall heat accumulated in mid to late September. The three individual blocks were picked just one week apart.

The fruit was harvested by hand and pressed directly, allowing the juice limited skin contact, and drawing out a translucent conch shell pink color and only a slight tannic punch. After pressing, the juice was settled then racked, including a fraction of light lees, to an approximate 50-50 mixture of stainless steel vessels and neutral French oak barrels to ferment. Once finished, the wine cellared in the same vessels for a few months before bottling.

The result is a white oleander floral rosé that races with lemon zest and crisp nectarine; then rounds to juicy white cherry, cranberry-raspberry compote and finishes with delicate wild strawberry, a hint of vanilla and a whisper of minerality in the glass.
