PINOT NOIR

A dynamic 2024 vintage brought an early harvest and concentrated wines to Anderson Valley. Abundant winter rainfall replenished vineyard soils and filled irrigation ponds, laying the groundwork for healthy early growth. Warm March weather brought an early budbreak and strong fruit set, while consistent warmth through spring and early summer steadily advanced the season. A sharp heat spike in July produced smaller yields with greater flavor intensity, accelerating ripening while retaining the freshness and structure that define Bearman Bend Vineyard. Harvest commenced at this site on September 4 and continued over three weeks, with each block picked at optimal maturity.

This single-vineyard bottling is crafted from heritage Pinot Noir selections—Mt. Eden, Calera, and a unique massale selection—each contributing depth and nuance to the final blend. Classic Anderson Valley Pinot Noir aromatics of black cherry and cola take front stage on the nose with subtle hints of black tea, Mission fig, and plum adding further complexity. On the palate, stone fruit and boysenberry unfold alongside notes of baking spice. Fine-grained tannins and bright acidity give the wine structure and lift, carrying it through a long, juicy finish.
