TASTING NOTES

APPEARANCE Hibiscus red

AROMAS

Raspberries and tart cranberries

PALATE Molasses with a hint of umami and cinnamon, dark cherries, a hint of smoked cedar

FINISH:

Elegant, light with a touch of oak

MOUTHFEEL Tart, fresh, lifted aromas through palate, nice entry with a resinous finish

AGEABILITY Given proper cellaring, this wine will give drinking pleasure through 2027

PAIRINGS Rich paella with andouille sausage and mussels, black trumpet risotto with freshly shaved parmesan

NOTES FROM THE VINEYARD

The year began with uncharacteristically hot, dry conditions, leading to early bud break. With a warm and wet spring, the vines finished bloom by late May. The early-season warmth, followed by a dry summer, led to a smaller crop than normal and berries with concentrated tannins. This year we were especially thankful for the Anderson Valley's cool maritime breezes, which preserved the grapes natural acidity during the heat of the afternoons. The result is a structured, balanced Pinot Noir with profoundly flavored bright, fresh red fruit.
