APPEARANCE

Rose gold

Crushed white rose petal, strawberry and apple blossom

PALATE

Lively, mouthwatering entry with bright raspberry and pomelo

MOUTHFEEL & FINISH

Juicy, broad and fresh with lingering citrus and minerality

NOTES FROM THE VINEYARD

A cool, dry winter was followed by mid-February warmth that jumpstarted the 2020 growing season in Anderson Valley. Budbreak began earlier than typical—around mid-March—and the vines were in full bloom by the end of May. Well-proportioned canopies and good fruit set marked the start of a promising season at our estate Bearman Bend Vineyard. We continued to see eager seasonal transitions as summer fell upon us with heat waves starting in June and consistently elevated temperatures lingering throughout the months of August and September. Due to the warm weather, we were met by a quick and condensed harvest, picking early to preserve the delicate berry aromas and palate energy we love in our Rosé. We selected only a single block of Pinot Noir with a fresh flavor profile to be used in our inaugural Rosé from Bearman Bend Vineyard.
